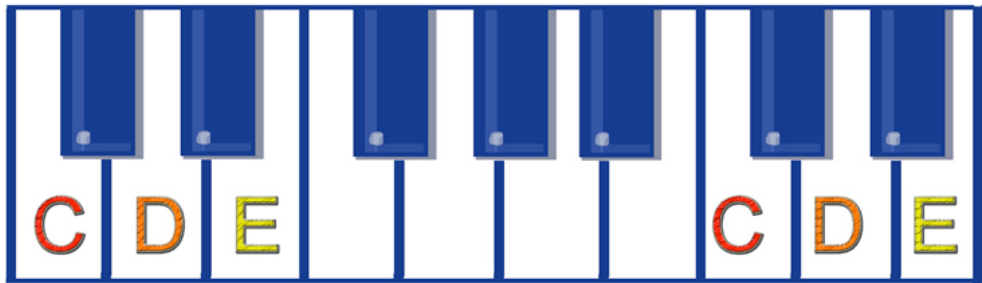


Quick way to learn the 7 note names:

1. C D E Groups



C, D and E are the three white notes surrounding any group of 2 black notes. Practice playing all groups of two black notes up and down the keyboard numerous times. Once you can easily find these, then practice playing the C-D-E notes. The piano keyboard consists of 7 white notes and 5 black notes that repeat in higher and lower pitches. However, the note NAMES remain the same, regardless of whether they are played higher or lower on the keyboard.

2. F G A B Group



F, G, A and B are the four white notes surrounding any group of 3 black notes. Practice playing all groups of three black notes up and down the keyboard numerous times. Once you can easily find any group of 3 black notes, then practice playing the white F-G-A-B notes..
